COVID 19-related updates

Nearly 87% of SU Academic Affairs employees are fully vaccinated against COVID and this percentage is similarly high in other divisions.

Campus Health continues to reach out to students to ask them to provide consent for the University to access their vaccination records but feels positive about the percentage of students who are already vaccinated.

Although there are some dark clouds on the horizon (e.g., delta variant, breakthrough infections), the USM and Campus Health Team recommend continuing with the safety protocols already in place.
