This form is considered complete ONLY when financial documentation is provided (e.g. letters from banks certifying availability of funds, letters of sponsorship from private sponsors, governments or employers). The Confidential Declaration of Finances is used to determine the applicant's ability to cover the cost of attending Salisbury University. All supporting documents must be **original, in English and amounts must be in U.S. dollars and issued within 12 months of application.** According to the United States Department of Homeland Security, Salisbury University may only issue a "Certificate of Eligibility" (I-20) if the applicant has been offered admission to this institution and has submit-
