SUBJECT Joint UCC and GCC proposal regarding curriculum terminology

MOTION

All program level curricular descriptions shall use the following terminology:

USM/MHEC define a Concentration as a program requiring 24 or more credit hours above the courses required for all programs in the major (24 or more credits above the major “core”). All SU programs that propose curriculum that have 24 or more credit hours in the concentration are required to go beyond internal SU curriculum approval to USM and MHEC approval.

A Track is 12-23 credit hours over the core above the courses required for all programs in the major (12-23 credits above the major “core”).

For programs with fewer than 12 credit hours above the required core, it is recommended that the term “focus” be used to capture those differences.

JUSTIFICATION

It is the opinion of UCC and GCC that Salisbury University’s internal curriculum terminology categorizing “concentrations”, “tracks”, and “focus” should match the definitions from USM and MHEC.

ANTICIPATED IMPACT:

Negative If this proposal goes forward, the changes to existing program terminology to correctly
