TITLE: Extension for updating Academic Integrity Policies to new USM Standards

MOTION (this section alone will be recorded in the minutes):

Resolved that the Faculty Senate extends the deadline for draft revisions to SU's academic integrity policies from the Academic Policies Committee (APC) to the first Senate meeting in February 2024.

JUSTIFICATION: The APC has made some progress on these revisions (a draft definition of academic integrity has been shared with the Ad Hoc Committee on the Faculty Handbook and areas that need modification have been identified and committee members are investigating how to best achieve those). However, some of the changes such as establishing a policy "to foster a culture of teaching and learning integrity on campus" require time to develop and articulate. Given the past and present workload of the APC, more time is needed to effectively develop and recommend changes.

ANTICIPATED IMPACT:

Negative: If submitted by the current deadline, the needed policy revisions that require time to develop will be incomplete.

Positive: An extension would allow the APC to develop robust academic integrity policies that adhere to the new USM standards.
